Section 17 MHA Apprehension in Community

The officer must have reasonable and probable grounds to believe a person is acting/has acted in a disorderly manner.

Past/Present Test: The officer must have reasonable cause to believe that the person:

- has threatened/threatening to cause bodily harm to self, or
- has attempted/attempting to cause bodily harm to self or others, or
- has behaved/behaving violently towards another person, or
- has caused/causing another person to fear bodily harm from self
- has shown/showing a lack of competence to care for self

Future Test:

The officers must be of the opinion that the person is apparently suffering from a mental disorder that will likely result in one or more of the following:

- serious bodily harm to self, or
- serious bodily harm to others, or
- serious physical impairment to self

The officer must be of the opinion that it would be dangerous to proceed by way of an application to a Justice of the Peace

Disorderly Manner has been interpreted by the courts to mean behaviour that is to some extent irrational, although not necessarily unruly. There is no need for the officer to have reasonable and probable grounds to believe that criminal conduct is occurring or has occurred.

EMOTIONALLY DISTURBED PERSON/ MENTAL HEALTH CALL BEST PRACTICES

NOTE "A" - Upon the issuance of a Form 1— Officers are urged to speak to the issuing physician to determine if they are required to stay at the hospital. Often, a delay occurs while staff attempt to find a psychiatric bed after the "Form" has been issued. If there is NO perceived safety/flight risk or obligation has been fulfilled. Hospital Staff are aware of this. Please urge staff to call police to return immediately should the circumstances change. Police are NOT to transport MHA/EDP persons to Schedule I psychiatric facilities unless again there is a safety/flight risk.

NOTE "B" - Upon the attendance/arrival or consultation with CAST—it is strongly recommended to follow any directions that are given in respect to the subjects condition or suggested treatment As always, such recommendations should be well documented.
