Terms of Reference

The Mental Health, Emergency, Police and Security Liaison Committee is a multi-agency, interdisciplinary body whose purpose is to promote system integration in the delivery of Emergency/Crisis services for individuals with a primary mental health and/or substance misuse disorder. In so doing the Committee will review challenging cases and develop policies, procedures and advocacy positions designed to address such issues and improve system performance.

Objectives:

1. To serve as a communications forum for issues of mutual interest and concern related to the provision of Emergency/Crisis care for individuals with mental health and/or substance misuse disorders
2. To identify, review and make recommendations with respect to operational challenges that arise in the provision of Emergency/Crisis care for individuals with mental health and/or substance misuse disorders
3. To develop or revise policies and procedures that relate to the provision of treatment and care to individuals with a mental health and/or substance misuse disorder
